



Sally and Billy live with their foster carers Molly and Frank. They have a cat called Tabby too. Every week Sally and Billy go to visit their Mum and Dad.






Some boys and girls like Sally and Billy are going to have video calls with their Mum and Dads because they can't go to see them. Not everyone is able to do this though.
